Be filled with peace at camp! Our summer theme is Peace Works: Empowering Peacemakers. Peace is something we wish to others as a blessing and a longing within each person's heart. Every culture has its own words and stories to describe peace and the work it requires. Scripture is filled with these stories, and campers will study, share and learn from them. Peace is not easy, but worth the effort because we know that peace works.

Your camper(s) have been registered for the camp listed on the accompanying invoice. Please confirm that your camper(s) have been registered for the correct camp. Occasionally, registered campers cannot come to camp. If this should happen to you, please notify us as soon as possible. This will give someone else a chance to come in your place. Thank you for taking time to do this.

Please review the information in the Camp Information document for details on what to bring and what not to bring to Camp Mennoscah, as well as directions, payment policies, and pick-up information. This document also has the scriptures for our summer theme.

Please note that for the best early registration discount, FULL payment must be **received by March 1**st. For the better early registration discount, FULL payment must be **received by April 1**st. If you are receiving a scholarship (church or other), you must let us know in order to receive the early registration discount. Scholarships must be received before camp starts. Third-party checks are not accepted. Checks must be made directly to Camp Mennoscah.

If the requirements are not met for the early registration discount, sibling discount, and free Bring a Friend tee shirts, the discount will be removed and you will be notified. We are happy to answer questions you may have.

Please note that cabinmate requests are not guaranteed. Requests from first-time campers are given priority.

We will do our best to honor dietary requests due to allergies and health issues, but cannot guarantee being able to meet all food requests. Any dietary needs must be conveyed to Camp Mennoscah no later than 2 weeks before the start of the camp. Those requesting vegetarian meals must mark "vegetarian" on their online registration. Please contact Camp Mennoscah for further information.

All medications which are sent to camp **must include** the pharmacist's original label with directions for use. If the camper requires medications which use special devices (such as syringes or electronic meters), please include these items with the medication supply. Over-the-counter medications **must be packaged** in the original manufacturer's container which clearly labels the contents.

For all camps except for First Camp, please register between 3:00-4:00pm on Sunday (not before). First Campers will register between **4:30-5:30pm** on Thursday. Sometimes campers need to leave for a time during the camp week. Please let us know if your camper(s) will be leaving during the camp week. Please pick up and drop off campers between the hours of 7:30am and 10pm. Contact Camp Mennoscah about other arrangements.

All First, Junior, and Junior High Camps close at 9:00am on Saturday. PreJunior Camps close at 9:00am on Thursday and Senior High Camp closes at 9:00am on Friday. You are expected to pick up your camper between 9:00-10:00am. Breakfast is the last meal served and all counselors and other staff leave camp soon after the children depart.
