Men and Boys Retreat Apr 16-18

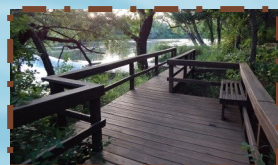

Register online at campmennoscah.org. A \$50 non-refundable, non-transferable pre-registration fee at time of enrollment (applied to camp fees) is required for each camper. To pay by check, select the check option at the payment screen and mail the check within one week to confirm registration. Instructions found online will walk you through the process. General Information:

Summer Youth Camps are designed to offer youth up to a week of worship and fun in the midst of God's creation. The camps offer a variety of activities including Bible Study, river play, crafts, swimming, interest groups and campfire worship.

A \$50 non-refundable, non-transferable pre-registration fee (applied to camp fees) at time of registration is required for each camper.

Camper health forms are pre-filled with some information from either 2019 or 2020, whichever is your most recent health form. Be sure to verify and update your information!

Cabinmate requests are not guaranteed. First time campers receive priority. Since we cannot guarantee cabinmate requests, please do not share suitcases. Sometimes there are changes in cabins during the registration process due to unforeseen circumstances.

Cancellations:

If you need to cancel, camp fees minus the pre-registration fee will be returned. Cancellations must be made at least 48 hours before the start of camp. Reduced rates for campers leaving early or arriving late are not offered.

Volunteer Opportunities:

Your time and skills are incredible gifts to us. If you would like to volunteer for a week of camp as a cook, kitchen assistant, or nurse, please contact us. Parents can receive a full discount for their camper. Contact Camp Mennoscah for further details or about other ways to volunteer during the summer or throughout the year.

Your early registration and sibling discounts can be donated to the Camp Mennoscah Renovation Fund. This fund is used for things like replacing water heaters or surprise repairs. Contact us at 620-297-3290 for more donation opportunities. Thank you for your support!

Scholarships:

Camp scholarship funds are available. Please contact Camp Mennoscah at 620-297-3290 or email us at office@campmennoscah.org. Scholarships are confidential.

Many churches also offer camp scholarships.

Church scholarships must be received by Camp Mennoscah before the first day of camp or the camper will be responsible for paying any remaining charges at the time of registration.

Free Bring a Friend Tee Shirt:

Returning campers and their first-time friends receive a free camp tee shirt when attending the same session. Please list your Bring a Friend when you register.

Discounts:

Summer Youth Camps have a 3-level fee structure based on when you register for camp. If you register and pay in full by **March 1**, you get the best price we can offer. If you register and pay in full by **April 1**, you get a much better price. From April 2 until the end of youth camps, you get a good price for a great week at Camp Mennoscah.

The **Sibling Discount** (\$10) applies to the second registered child and additional children from the same family to attend summer youth camp. The first child pays full camp fees according to the fee structure above. For summer youth camps only.

Donation Items:
