Camp Mennoscah 2025 Pricing Worksheet

All activity areas are shared (playground, sports fields, canoes, pool, etc.) Groups are asked to be aware and respectful of other people and groups using the campgrounds.

Main Camp reservations include dining hall/kitchen, shelter areas, cabins, the Cottonwood and Sunflower bunk houses, and use of the bell. Both bunk houses are centrally heated. (Note: the Cottonwood bunk house is not available June to mid-August. Check with camp staff to confirm when this building is available.)

Tent/RV areas usually share facilities with the Main Camp but these areas are not available during summer youth camps (usually Sunday through Friday in June and July). There are two 20 amp RV hookups and two 30 amp RV hookups available in the south (boys) cabin area on a pole of the gazebo. The hookups/outlets are not spread out. Please communicate with others in your group, if there may be high demand for RV hookups. Camp Mennoscah only has electrical hookups.

Currently Unavailable--The Retreat Center has 16 rooms available. Most rooms have two twin beds and share a bathroom between two rooms. The gazebo next to the Retreat Center is designated for Retreat Center use. Costs are calculated per room, per night for 1 to 2 people. A third person sharing the room will incur an additional fee.

Currently Unavailable-- The Bluestem house is located on the township (dirt) road before you reach the main camp driveway. Bluestem's main floor comprises of living room, large, fully equipped kitchen, two full bathrooms and three bedrooms. Two main floor bedrooms have 1 double bed, with the third bedroom containing 2 double beds. The basement has a gathering area with foosball & ping pong tables, two bathrooms, and two bedrooms. Each bedroom in the basement contains 3 bunk beds each. TV/DVD and PA system are not available at Bluestem.

Expectations of groups reserving camp areas;

- No Smoking/Tobacco use or Vaping
- No Guns or Weapons • No Hunting

No Alcohol

- No disruption of worship services or activities of others using the campgrounds

Violations of Camp Policies could result in termination of your stay and forfeiture of deposits and all fees.

The cost for a group's stay is calculated as either the total per-person rate or the minimum facility charges per night, depending on which is greater. (For example, a two-night stay at Main Camp has a minimum charge of $\$375 \times 2 = \750 .) The deposit is applied to the total cost at the end of the stay. Day rates apply to all who attend Camp Mennoscah, regardless of the length of time. Children 2 and under are free.
